

Glossary

I'd like = I would like. (a polite way to say 'I want')

take away eat in another place (not in the café)

two coffees two cups of coffee (also **two teas**, etc.)

a couple of minutes two or three minutes

have a seat sit down

Yes, please? = 'What would you like?'

Yes, please is a polite way to say 'yes'.
