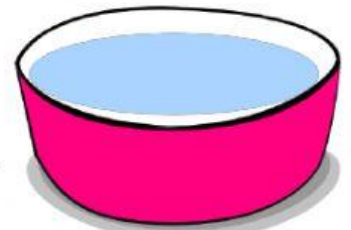


Harry waited for the family to go, then he slowly opened the cage door with his mouth.
