- Do NOT add extra spaces
- Keep brackets

$1) 18 + 4 \times 2$

$2) 25 - 12 \div 3$

$3) 24 + 36 \div 9$

$4) 5 \times (4 + 11)$

$5) 81 \div 9 - 6$

$6) (99 \times 10) - (30 + 30)$

$7) (1000 + 6000) \times 3$

$8) 6 + 125 \div 25 =$

$9) 60 \times 3 \div 9$

Mrs. Young has bought 2 boxes of granola bars for 3 teachers to share. Each box has 6 bars. The granola bars are shared equally. How many granola bars did each teacher get? Write a number sentence to show the order of operations you need.
