Modals: rules &amp; obligation

We use **have to** and **must** to tell someone to do something, to talk about rules, or when something is necessary.

*In the UK, students **have to** wear a school uniform.*

*My brother **has to** study for an exam.*

*Does Andrew **have to** tidy his room?*

*I **must** buy my mum a birthday present tomorrow.*

*All customers **must** queue for tickets here.*

We use **mustn't** to tell someone **not** to do something.

*You **mustn't** write in this space.*

We use **don't/ doesn't have to** when something **isn't** necessary.

*We **don't have to** wear a uniform at my school.*


