- You have to get a tourist visa before you arrive. You can do this online.
- Tourists can stay for a maximum of three, six, or twelve months.
- You can't work in Australia without a work visa. You have to get a visa from the Australian Embassy in your country or online.

- The currency is Australian dollars.
- Most shops, hotels, and banks in large cities accept credit cards.
- In smaller towns, always have cash with you.

- Australia is a multicultural country, so there are many different languages.
- Most people speak or understand English.

- The climate is different in different areas of the country.
- Summers are very hot and the temperature is often over 40°C. Always use lots of sunscreen and wear a hat.
