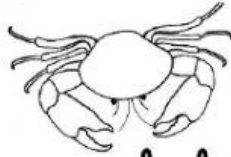


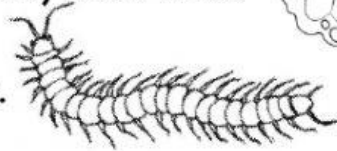
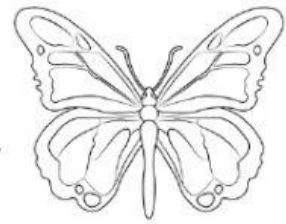
Arthropods

- They have 3 parts: head, thorax and abdomen/stomach.



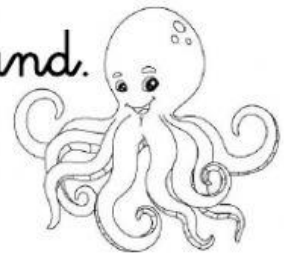
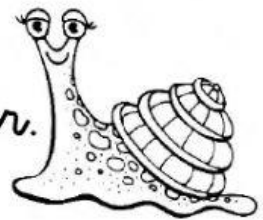
Molluscs

- They live in water/air and on land.

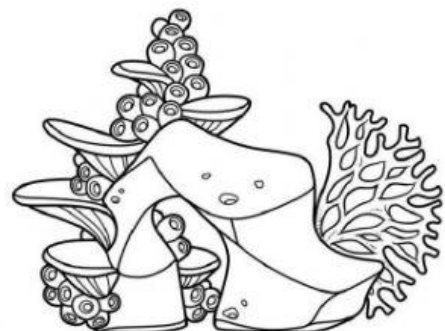


Cnidarians

- They are divided into segments/three parts.

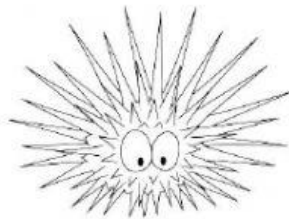


- They have a short/long and soft/hard body.
