- There are many different types.

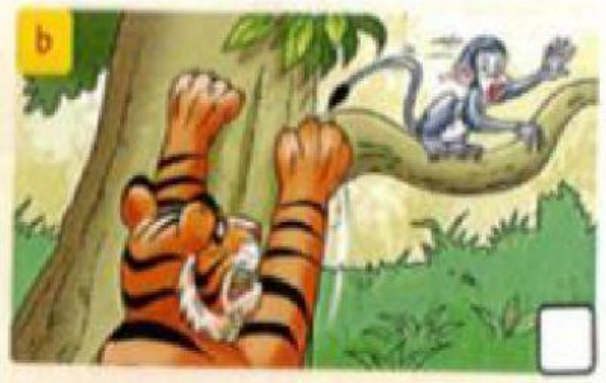
