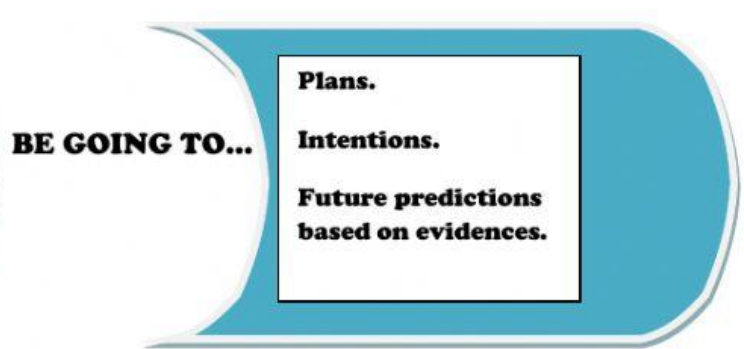


FUTURE: WILL VS. BE GOING TO
