

1. Borucas are well known for their Fiesta de los Diablito, \_\_\_\_\_ (**due to / even though / however**) its festival to celebrate their resistance and cultural survival against the conquerors.
2. \_\_\_\_\_ (**since/ on the other hand / but**) Chorotegas are excellent farmers and produce crops such as cotton, cacao, corn, and beans, they are the most developed tribal group in Costa Rica.
3. The Huetar's crafts can be found in the roadside stands all around the community; \_\_\_\_\_ (**therefore / however / since**) the main income is generated by workers finding employment in nearby San Jose.
4. The Huetar's (Quitirrisi), has somewhat lost all of their culture, along with their mother tongue; \_\_\_\_\_ (**on the other hand, however, moreover**) they still do practice the tradition of "Fiesta del Maiz"
5. \_\_\_\_\_ (**although / however / on the other hand**) Malekus tribe is one of the smallest indigenous groups in Costa Rica, they are trying to hold on to their native language.
6. The Boruca tribe is still trying to preserve their identity due to it is the only group that was not conquered by the Spaniards. \_\_\_\_\_ (**however / although/ on the other hand**) the Chorotegan people, as they live on the Nicoya Peninsula they were trapped and conquered.
7. People pretend to ignore indigenous people; \_\_\_\_\_ (**on the other hand / however / even though**) they represent an important part of the culture.
