

Imparfait ou Passé Composé

The **passé composé** talks about specific actions that were completed in the past.

L'imparfait describes actions that were ongoing or repeated in the past. It can be used when you say "was" "were" "would" "used to".

1. I went swimming with my mom yesterday. (imparfait /passé composé)
2. I was working on my homework until late last night. (imparfait /passé composé)
3. We were going to have a pizza party but then I got sick. (imparfait /passé composé)(imparfait /passé composé)
4. I used to hate it when my friends called me by my full name. (imparfait /passé composé)(imparfait /passé composé)
5. I would go to Elkwater every weekend when I was younger. (imparfait /passé composé)(imparfait /passé composé)
