*The passé composé talks about specific actions that were completed in the past.*

*L'imparfait describes actions that were ongoing or repeated in the past. It can be used when you say “was” “were” “would” “used to”.*

1. I went swimming with my mom yesterday. (imparfait /passé composé)
2. I was working on my homework until late last night. (imparfait /passé composé)
3. We were going to have a pizza party but then I got sick. (imparfait /passé composé)(imparfait /passé composé)
4. I used to hate it when my friends called me by my full name. (imparfait /passé composé)(imparfait /passé composé)
5. I would go to Elkwater every weekend when I was younger. (imparfait /passé composé)(imparfait /passé composé)
