- Tells the reader true things about something
(a person, place, or thing)



- Does **NOT** tell opinions or personal narratives

What You Need

1. Introduction
 - ✓ Tell reader what they'll learn about
2. Body
 - ✓ Tell facts about the subject
3. Closing
 - ✓ Remind readers what they learned about

- Uses text features
(photographs, diagrams, labels)

Writing Process

STEP 1: Brainstorming

What you would like to share or say in this text?

Step 2: Researching

Find facts about the topic.

Step 3: Drafting

Use the ideas of the graphic organizer and start expressing your ideas.

(Conclusions - Main idea)

Details: Explain the main idea.

Step 4: Revising

Check ideas and paragraph order. Check grammar and punctuation.
Revise final conclusions.

Step 5: Publishing
