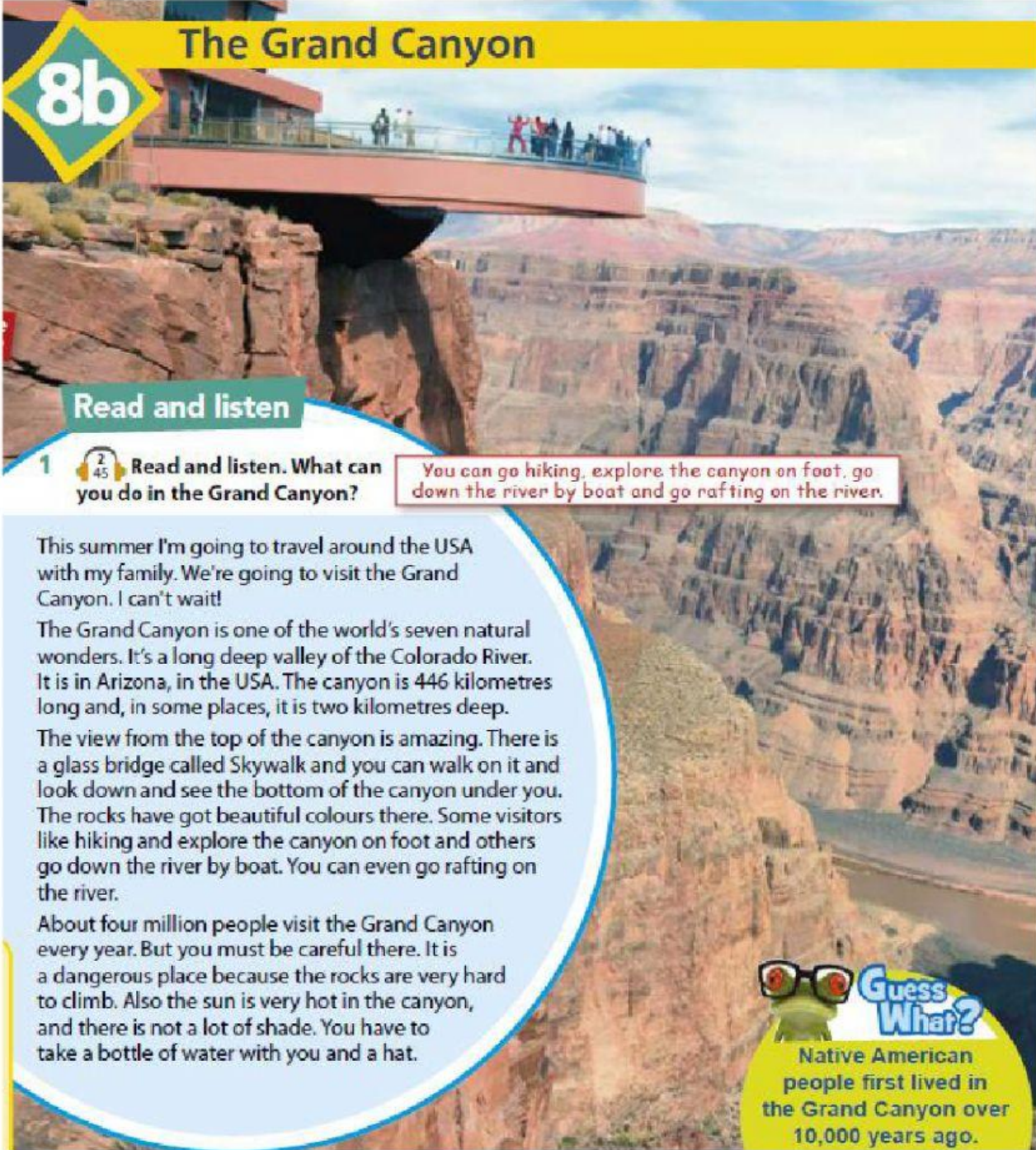

The Grand Canyon is one of the world's seven natural wonders. It's a long deep valley of the Colorado River. It is in Arizona, in the USA. The canyon is 446 kilometres long and, in some places, it is two kilometres deep.

The view from the top of the canyon is amazing. There is a glass bridge called Skywalk and you can walk on it and look down and see the bottom of the canyon under you. The rocks have got beautiful colours there. Some visitors like hiking and explore the canyon on foot and others go down the river by boat. You can even go rafting on the river.

About four million people visit the Grand Canyon every year. But you must be careful there. It is a dangerous place because the rocks are very hard to climb. Also the sun is very hot in the canyon, and there is not a lot of shade. You have to take a bottle of water with you and a hat.
