

WH Questions

➤ **What are the WH Questions?**

WH questions are a set of question words that are used to ask something like asking the time, place, person, object, thing, reason, method, and so on. WH questions can also be called open questions because of their nature which explains something, not just to get a yes/no answer. In English, this type of question is called the WH Question, because all questions start with the words W+H, such as what, where, when, why, which, who, whom, whose (who belongs), and how. Without realizing it, we learn this WH question in our daily life at school, or even when we talk to our friends in English.

➤ **The WH Questions Formula**

WH + Auxiliary Verb (to be, do, have) + Subject + Main Verb + ?

Example:

- What are you doing?
- Where do you live?

WH + Modal Auxiliary (can, could, will, would, shall, should, may, might, must) + Subject + Main Verb + ?

Example:

- When will we go to the concert?
- What should I do if she doesn't accept me?

➤ The Types of WH Questions

○ **What**

What is used to ask an information about something.

Example:

- What is your name?
- What are you doing?

○ **Where**

Where is used to ask about location or place.

Example:

- Where is your home?
- Where are your parents?

○ **When**

When is used to ask about the time.

Example:

- When will you but that book from me?
- When does the bus arrive?

○ **Why**

Why is used to ask about a reason.

Example:

- Why do you leave me?
- Why do you happy last night?

○ **Which**

Which is used to ask from the certainty of a choice among people, things, or things.

Example:

- Which one do you like, the green one or the red?
- Which house is yours?

○ **Who**

Who is used to ask about person or people.

Example:

- Who is your father?
- Who is the most actor in the world?

○ **Whom**

Whom is used to ask about a person, where the person in question is the object of the sentence or it can also be said that the person called receives the action.

Example:

- Whom are you going to go?
- Whom will you marry with?

○ **Whose**

Whose is used to ask which person owns something

Example:

- Whose bag is it?
- Whose house is this?

○ **How**

How is used to ask how something can be done.

Example:

- How are you?
- How old are you?
