



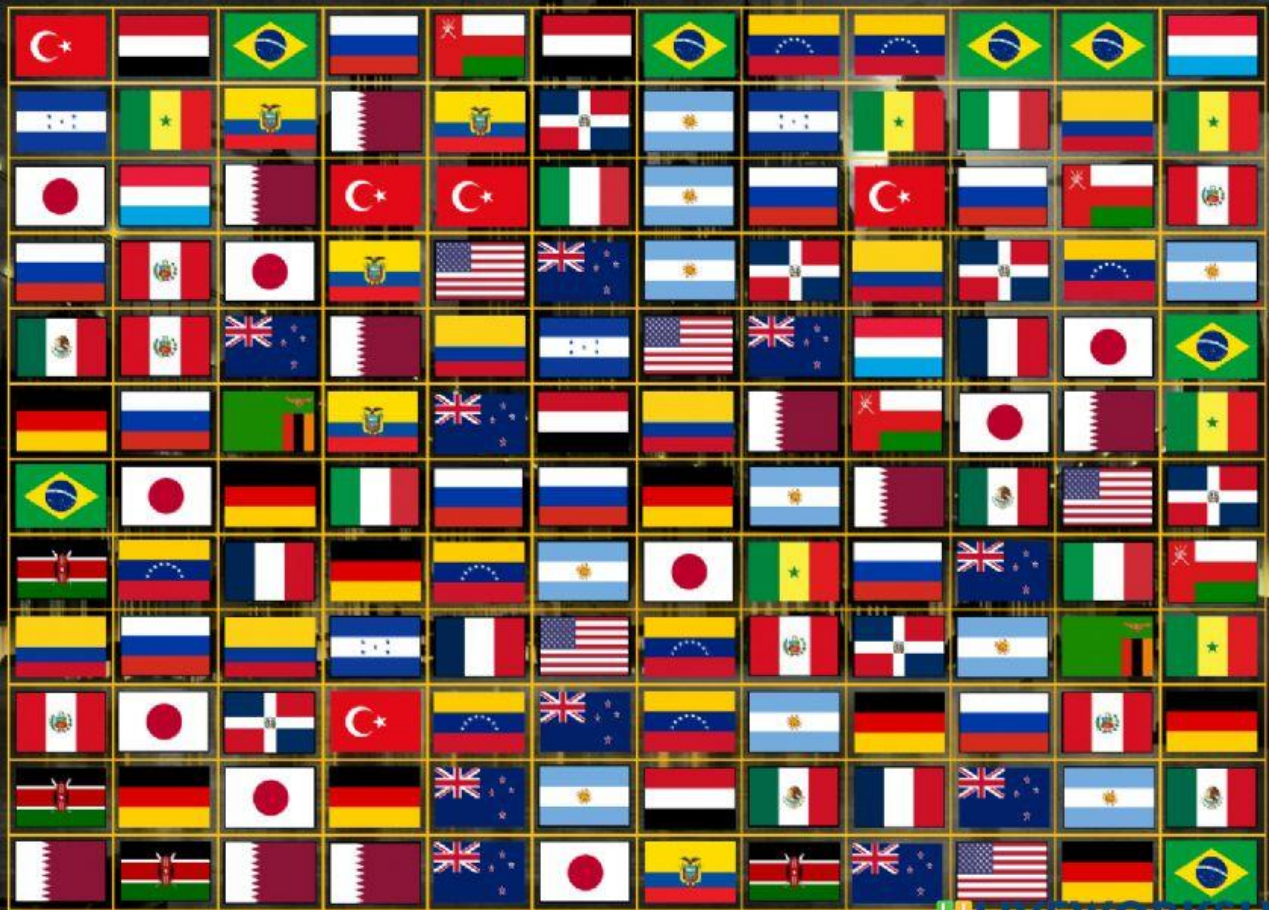

1. Where are the rivers that have no water?



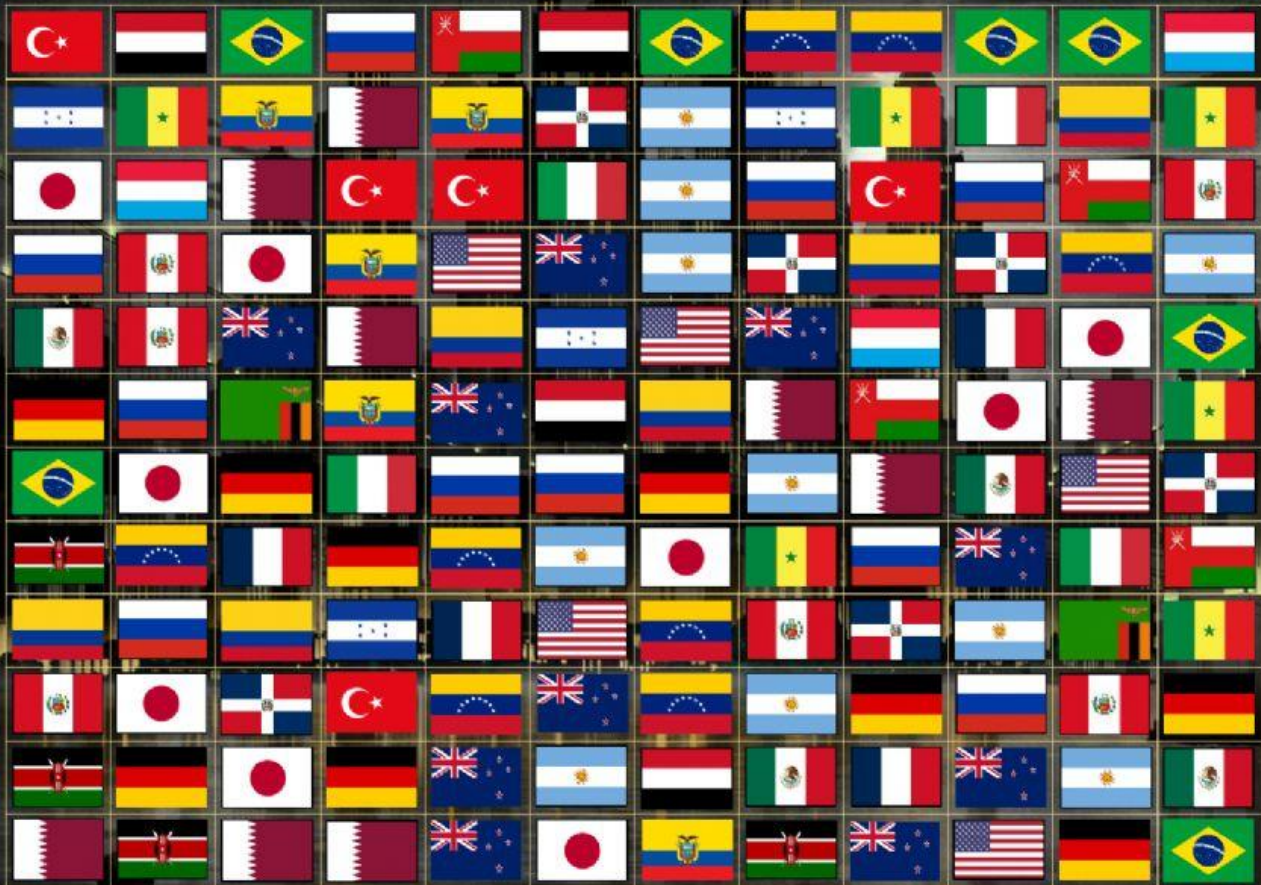
2. Put me aside and I'll be everything. Cut me in half and I'll be nothing. What am I?



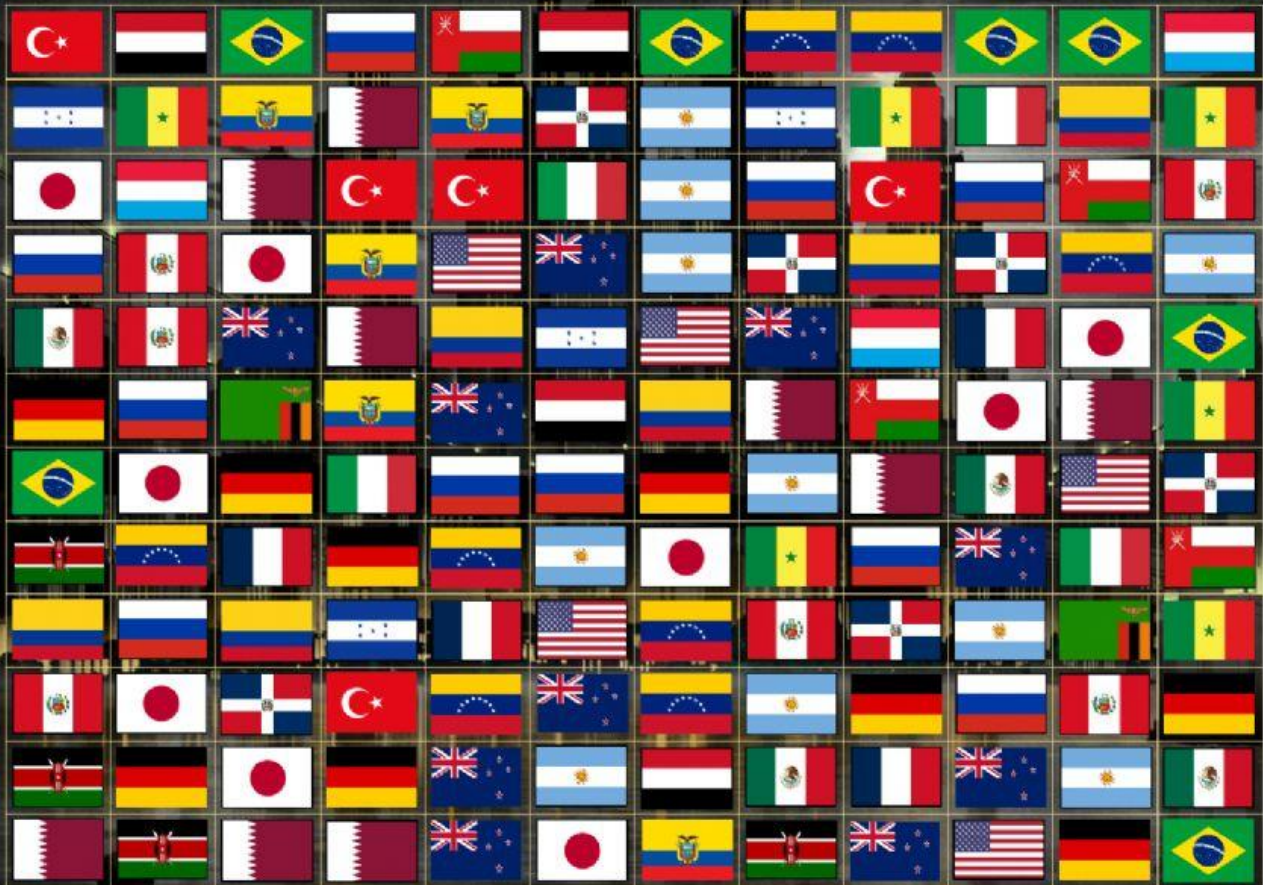
3. Everyone has it and no one can lose it. What is it?



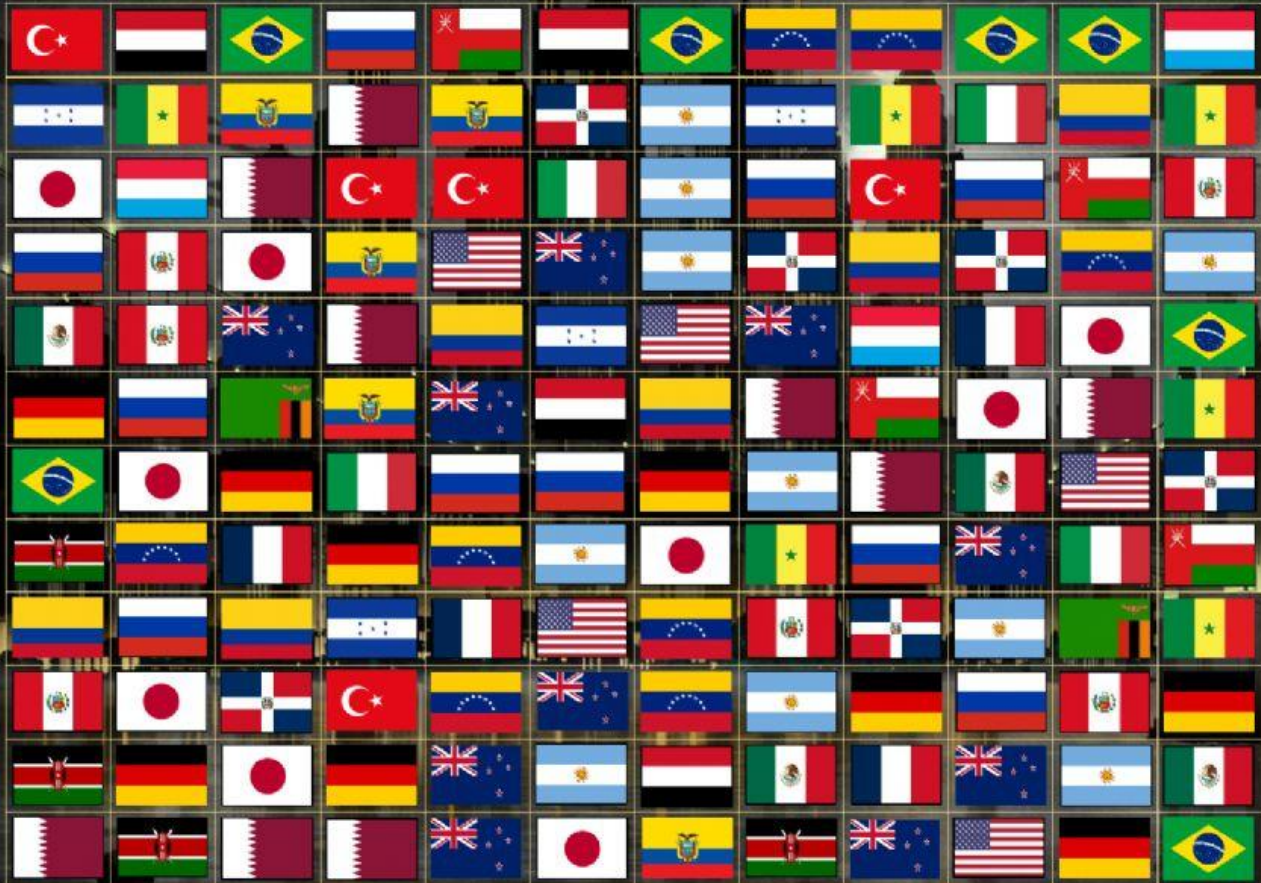
4. Yesterday I was 16 and next year I will be 17. If my birthday is tomorrow, what month was I born in?



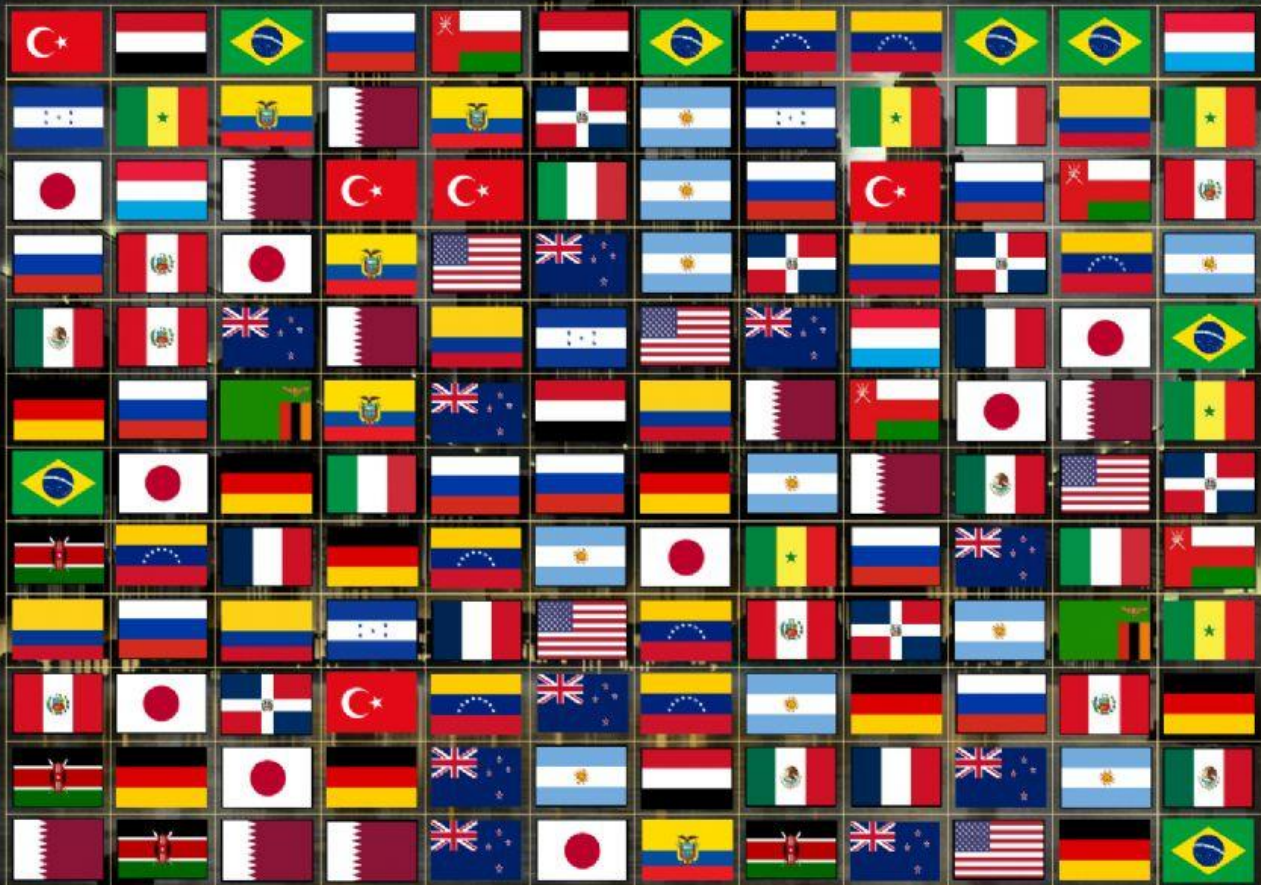
5. If I am young, I'll stay young. If I'm old, I remain old. I have a mouth but I don't speak, I have eyes but I don't see. What am I?
