

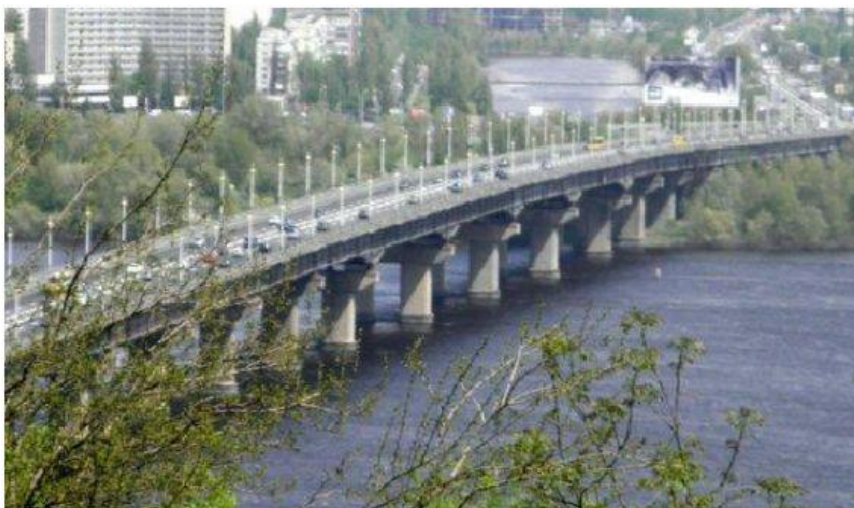
Eugene Paton
