ROZPOZNANIE CZASÓW

PRESENT SIMPLE

- czasownik w podstawowej formie, bez żadnej końcówki
- czasownik z końcówką '-s' w 3. osobie (she/he/it)

Np. He **make**s furniture for them. -> They have furniture made.

PAST SIMPLE

- czasownik z końcówką '-ed', '-ied'
- czasownik w nieregularnej formie (II)

Np. He **made** furniture for them. -> They had furniture made.
