More than 20% of all the world's freshwater, nearly 5,400 cubic miles, is in the Great Lakes. In order of water capacity, Lake Superior holds the most, 2,900 cubic miles, Lake Michigan the second most, Lake Huron third, Lake Ontario fourth and Lake Erie the least.
