1. People from different cultures sometimes have misunderstandings because they can interpret the same thing differently.
2. Some behaviors that are polite in one culture can seem polite in another culture.
3. Cultural meanings are symbolic because their meaning comes through interpretation, not through observation.
4. Greetings, for example, vary widely from culture to culture.
5. Other cultural differences are more general and are the result of differences in habits.
6. When they communicate in high-context cultures, they use the full context to understand a message.
7. In a low-context culture messages are made explicit through words. Speakers do not leave key parts of the message unsaid, and what is said is interpreted more literally.
