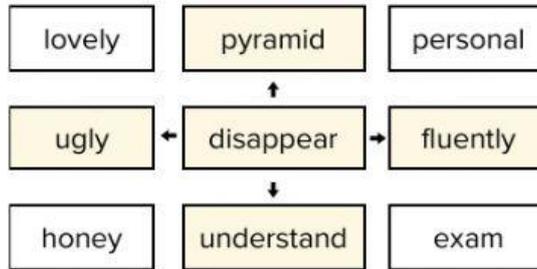


Syllable Mazes

1. Enter at ← **IN** and exit at ← **OUT**.
2. Connect one word to another that is above, below, or across from it. You **cannot** connect words diagonally. (↖ ↗ ↘ ↙) *Example:* The word “disappear” can only connect with “pyramid,” “ugly,” “understand” or “fluently.” It cannot connect with “lovely,” “honey,” “personal” or “exam.”



3. If you are using your notebook, write the connected words in order.

Maze A (Words with 2 syllables)

New rules: Connect **only words with TWO** syllables.

Maze B (Words with 3 syllables)

New rules: Connect **only words with THREE** syllables.
