Not many people supported their decision to choose the Eiffel design because nothing of that kind had ever been built before. The tower was intended to stand for only 20 years but it could stay longer. This is because other changes were made to the tower that made it more useful. Those include a weather station in 1890 and a telegraph station in 1903. These days, the Eiffel Tower attracts millions of tourists yearly.
