Subject + is/ am/ are + Verb 3

Active voice: I made a cake.

Passive voice: A cake **was made** by me.

Grammar: Active & Passive Voice

Vocabulary: คำศัพท์

- **consist of (v.):** to be formed from two or more things or people (ประกอบด้วย)
- **mixture (n.):** a combination of two or more different things, feelings, or types of people (ส่วนผสม)
- **freeze (v.):** to preserve food for a long time by keeping it at a very low temperature, or to be preserved in this way (แช่แข็ง)
- **chamber (n.):** a room used for a special purpose (ห้อง, กรง)
- **voyage (n.):** a long journey in a ship or spacecraft (การเดินทาง โดยเรือ)
- **expert (n.):** someone who has a special skill or special knowledge or subject, gained as a result of training or experience (ผู้เชี่ยวชาญ)
- **champagne (n.):** a French white wine with a lot of bubbles, drunk on special occasions (แชมเปญ, เหล้าอู่่นขาวชนิด ขัน)
- **diamond (n.):** a very hard, clear, valuable stone, used in jewelry (เพชร)
- **limestone (n.):** a type of rock that contains calcium (หินปูน)
