THE FORTUNE TELLER

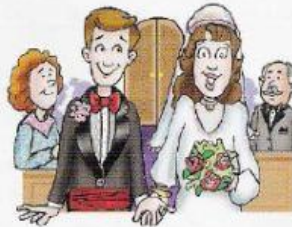

In September he's going to start a new job with a very big salary.

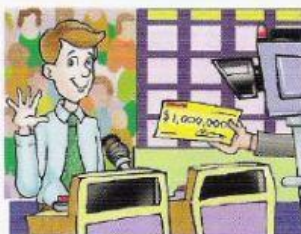
