Regular	→	clean	cleaner
Ends with e	→	nice	nicer
Ends with consonant + y	→	easy	easier
Ends with consonant + vowel + consonant	→	big	bigger

Long Adjectives

beautiful	more beautiful
dangerous	more dangerous
expensive	more expensive

Irregular Adjectives

good	better
bad	worse
far	farther/further
