A. GRAMMAR

***Lưu ý:** Các từ vựng mở rộng thầy cô cho ghi trong vở (nếu có) và các từ vựng mở rộng trong phiếu đề có chú thích nghĩa: con về nhà chép mỗi từ 1 dòng để ghi nhớ nhé.

I. Questions in reported speech (Câu hỏi trong câu tường thuật)

- Câu hỏi được tường thuật bằng cách sử dụng “ask” (hoặc một số động từ khác như “wanted to know” hoặc “wondered”) + từ hỏi + mệnh đề. Bên cạnh đó cần áp dụng quy tắc lùi thì đối với động từ.

Câu trực tiếp	“Wh + trợ động từ + S ₁ + V?”, S ₂ asked sb.
Câu gián tiếp	S ₂ + asked / wanted to know / wondered sb + Wh + S ₁ + V (lùi thì).
Ex: “ <i>What do you want?</i> ”, Lan asked her father. → <i>Lan asked her father what he wanted.</i>	

II. Statements in reported speech (Câu trần thuật trong câu tường thuật)

- Câu trần thuật được tường thuật lại bằng cách sử dụng “said” hoặc “told” + mệnh đề. Bên cạnh đó cần áp dụng quy tắc lùi thì đối với động từ.

Câu trực tiếp	“S ₁ + V + O.”, S ₂ said (to sb).
Câu gián tiếp	S ₂ + said / told sb (that) + S ₁ + V (lùi thì) + O
Ex: “ <i>My sister has visited Japan recently.</i> ”, she said. → <i>She said (that) her sister had visited Japan recently.</i>
