Yuri Gagarin, the first man ever in space, was born near Moscow, Russia on March 9, 1934. He died in 1968, just seven years after his space flight. At the age of 21, Yuri became a member of the Soviet Air Force and trained to be a cosmonaut. Yuri orbited the Earth in a spacecraft named Vostok 1, which consisted of two parts: one for Yuri and the other for his supplies of oxygen and water. Vostok 1 circled the Earth in 108 minutes at 27,400 kilometers per hour. Yuri's return to Earth was controlled by a computer and he landed by parachute after being ejected from the spacecraft.
