

## **CONDITIONAL SENTENCES – TYPES 2 AND 3**

### **EX 1 COMPLETE THE CONDITIONAL SENTENCES (TYPE 2) BY PUTTING THE VERBS INTO THE CORRECT FORM.**

1. If I (be) ..... rich, my life (change) ..... completely.

5. If the dress ..... (not / be) so tight (small), I ..... (wear) it tonight.


