France is famous for making great cheese. Carrefour sells a lot of cheeses. People can try wonderful French cheese with just a trip to the store in their country.



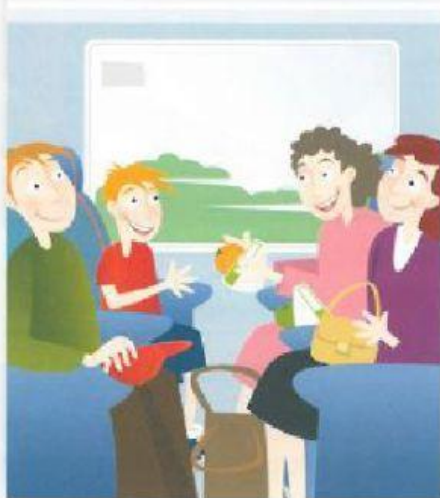
In the past, it was hard to try products from other countries. But today it's easy, thanks to stores like Carrefour.
