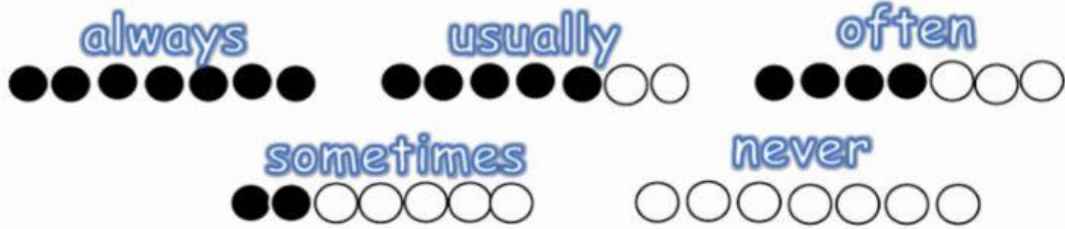


ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY
