

COUNTABLE OR UNCOUNTABLE

RULES

- You can count the countable nouns (an apple, two apples)
- You can't count the uncountable nouns (a rice, a sugar, a love)
- Uncountable nouns are always used with "singular verbs"

SOME UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS

- ABSTRACT NOUNS (love, hate)
- GASES (smoke, air)
- LIQUIDS (water, milk)
- SUBSTANCES WITH SMALL PARTICLES (sugar, tea, sand)

- olive oil is there in the bottle?
- bananas are there in the basket?
- lemon juice is there in the cup?
- potatoes do you need for the meal?
- salad will you prepare for the dinner?

"SOME", "ANY", "A" or "AN"

- There isn't meat in the fridge
- There is carrot in the plate
- Are there lemons in the basket?
- There is rice in the bottle
- There isn't sugar at home.
