INGREDIENTS

(1) $\frac{1}{2}$ cup rice flour
(2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups coconut milk
(3) $\frac{1}{2}$ cup freshly grated coconut (or $\frac{1}{2}$ cup unsweetened dried coconut flakes moistened with 1-2 tbsp water)
(4) 1 tbsp salt
(5) 3 pandan leaves (tied in a knot)
Palem sugar
(1) 1 pandan leaf
(2) $\frac{1}{2}$ cup palm sugar (grated or crumbled)
(3) $\frac{1}{4}$ cup water

INSTRUCTIONS

To make palm sugar syrup:
Tear pandan leaf into strips and tie strips together in a knot. In a small saucepan, add pandan leaf, sugar, and $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of water. Simmer for about 5 minutes. Keep stirring until sugar is completely dissolved. Take out pandan leaf and pour syrup through a sieve into a bowl. Set aside to cool.

To make the *bubur*:

- (1) In a mixing bowl, combine the coconut milk, rice flour and $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp salt. Pour mixture through a sieve to remove lumps.
- (2) Place the mixture in a non-stick saucpan, add pandan leaves and cook the mixture on low heat for about 15-20 mins. While cooking, stir constantly until the mixture thickens and starts to boil. Remove from the heat and pour into serving bowls.
- (3) Combine the grated coconut and salt, and mix well.
- (4) To serve, top *bubur sumsum* with palm sugar syrup.
