

I. Use the correct verb tense (Chia dạng đúng của động từ theo thì)



Các bước để chia thì đúng:

- (1): Xác định **khung thời gian/dấu hiệu** của thì.
- (2): Xác định **chủ ngữ** của câu.
- (3): **Chia động từ**.

Ex.1: Tom has been working on this project for two months. (and he is still working on it – hành động xảy ra trong quá khứ và kéo dài đến hiện tại).

Ex.2: She had already eaten breakfast when I arrived. (hành động đã kết thúc tại một thời điểm cụ thể trong quá khứ).

II. What = “the thing(s) which/that” (giải thích đại từ quan hệ *what*)

- ❖ Trong câu ví dụ dưới đây, từ “**what**” không dùng để hỏi, mà dùng như một đại từ để chỉ “the thing(s) which/that” ((những) thứ mà, (những) điều mà...)

Ex: *You should be responsible for **what** you've done.* = *You should be responsible for **the things***

***which/that** you've done.*

- ❖ Mở rộng: “What a(n)...” là cách **bắt đầu một câu cảm thán**, dùng để bày tỏ ý kiến, cảm xúc mạnh mẽ.

Ex: *What a mess!*

Mount Fuji

For the Japanese, Mount Fuji has long been the ultimate (0) of beauty. It is incredibly beautiful when seen from any (1) , at all times of day and in any season.
