Fashion design is the art of the application of design and aesthetics or natural beauty to clothing and accessories. Fashion design is influenced by cultural and social latitudes, and has varied over time and place. Fashion designers work in a number of ways in designing clothing and accessories; and, because of the time required to bring a (21) _____ onto the market, must at times anticipate changing consumer tastes.

Fashion designers attempt to design clothes which are (22) _____ as well as aesthetically pleasing. They must consider who is (23) _____ to wear something and the situations in which it will be worn. They have a wide (24) _____ and combinations of materials to work with as well as colours, (25) _____ and styles to choose from. Though most clothing worn for everyday wear falls within a small variety of conventional styles, unusual clothes are usually sought for special occasions such as evening wear or party dresses.

Some clothes are made specifically for an (26) _____, as in the case of haute couture . Today, most clothing is designed for the mass market, especially casual and every-day wear.

Fashion designers can work in a number of many ways. Fashion designers may work full-time for one fashion as 'in-house designers' which owns the designs. They may work (27) _____ or as part of a team. Freelance designers work for themselves, selling their designs to fashion houses, directly to shops, or to clothing manufacturers. The clothes bear the buyer's label. Some fashion designers set up their own labels, under which their designs are marketed. Some fashion designers are self-employed and design for individual clients. Other high-fashion designers cater to specialty stores or high-fashion (28) _____ stores. These designers create original clothes, as well as those that follow established fashion (29) _____. Most fashion designers, however, work for clothes manufacturers, creating designs of men's, women's, and children's fashions for the mass market. Large designer brands which have a 'name' as their (30) _____ such as Abercrombie & Fitch, Justice, or Juicy are likely to be designed by a team of individual designers under the direction of a designer director.
