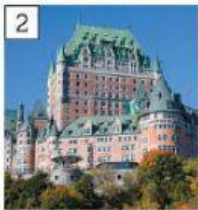

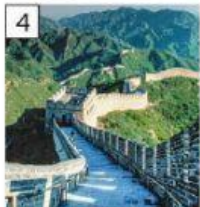

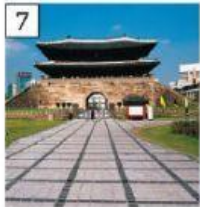

• **he** = man (♂), **she** = woman (♀), **it** = thing
he = hombre (♂), **she** = mujer (♀), **it** = cosa

• You can also contract *is not* like this:

Ud. también puede abreviar **is not**, así:

He's not from the US.

She's not from Japan.

It's not from Mexico.
