Reading comprehension

Martioda is a wildlife rehabilitation center located in Álava. Its goal is to return fully recovered injured animals to nature. 75% of the animals they attend to are birds, the rest are mammals or reptiles. Among the birds, the ones that enter the most are birds of prey.

The period of greatest entry of animals is from May to September, coinciding with migration. The majority of "patients" arrive at the hospital after being hit by a car, shot, or poisoned.

What to do with an injured animal

Observe him first and make sure he needs help. Then put it in a box with holes to transport it to the center. Do not give him food or water. Finally, take references from the place where you found it. You can also call 112 to come pick it up.
