


1. According to the following Reading answer the questions below

The discovery of America refers to the arrival of Christopher Columbus in the New World in 1492. Columbus was an Italian explorer who sailed across the Atlantic Ocean with three ships: the Niña, the Pinta, and the Santa Maria. His goal was to find a new route to Asia to trade goods and to spread Christianity.



On October 12, 1492, Columbus landed on an island in the Caribbean Sea, which he named San Salvador. He then explored other islands in the area, including Cuba and Hispaniola, where he established the first Spanish settlement in the New World.

Columbus's discovery of America led to a series of expeditions by European powers to explore and colonize the New World. These expeditions had a significant impact on the indigenous people of the Americas, leading to the displacement and destruction of many native cultures.

It's worth noting that the idea of "discovery" is Eurocentric and ignores the fact that the Americas were already inhabited by indigenous peoples who had their own cultures, histories, and societies long before Columbus arrived.
