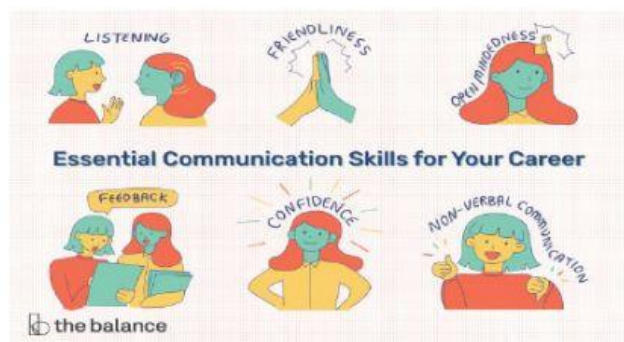


Some of them are: Delegation, negotiation, conflict resolution, empathetic listening, decision-making, communication, team-building, analytical thinking, etc.

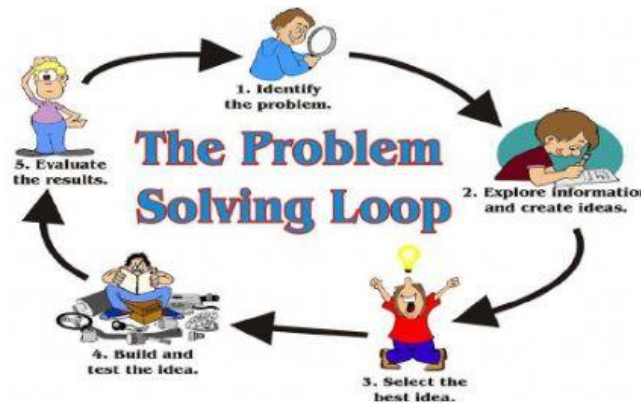




Leadership skills: They are essential in all types of roles, even if you're not directly managing a group. Some of those skills are: Team building, adaptability, _____, decision-making, etc.
