

PAST SIMPLE & PRESENT PERFECT

PAST SIMPLE

1. Lina and Doon **exchanged** jobs **on Assignment Day**.
2. Granny **died** **before the singing**.
3. Lina always **went** with her **father** to the Greenhouses.
4. **When Granny was young** she **tried** lots of delicious foods.

These sentences are in the **past simple** because they are specific actions or situations in **one moment in the past** OR they are things that happened regularly in the past but **cannot happen anymore**. These actions are **finished**.

The **time expressions** used in the sentences show that **finitude**:

- two years ago
- in the past
- (It is obvious if we refer to someone who is dead as in 3)
- in 2001
- when she was kid
- last week
- on my birthday

PRESENT PERFECT

1. Mrs. Murdo **has just offered** Lina to live with her.
2. Lina and Lizzie **have been** friends **for 10 years**.
3. Granny's death **has left** a void in Lina's life.
4. Lina **has never eaten** Pineapple. She **has tried** sweet corn **only once**.

These sentences are in the **present perfect** because they are actions or situations that: happened very **recently** OR started in the past but **continue in the present** OR happened in the past but **affect the present** OR refer to life **experiences that may repeat**.

The **time expressions** don't refer to a single specific point in time:

- just, already, yet
- recently, lately
- (Sometimes we don't use time expression as in 3)
- for 5 years
- this year, so far
- since kinder
- never, once, three times
