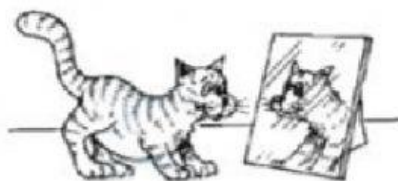


REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

Reflexive pronouns end in **-self / selves**. They are used when the subject (e.g., I) and the object (e.g., myself) are the same person. The action of the verb is pointed back to the subject of the sentence.

INCORRECT: I saw me in the mirror.

- ✚ Myself I saw myself in the mirror.
- ✚ Yourself.....You (one person) saw yourself.
- ✚ Herself.....She saw herself.
- ✚ Himself.....He saw himself.
- ✚ Itself.....It (e.g., the kitten) saw itself.
- ✚ Ourselves.....We saw ourselves.
- ✚ Yourselves.....you (plural) saw yourselves.
- ✚ Themselves.....They saw themselves.



- ✚ Greg lives by himself.
- ✚ I sat by myself on the park bench.

By + a reflexive pronoun = alone.

Greg lives alone, without family or roommates.

- ✚ I enjoy myself at the fair.

Enjoy and a few other verbs are commonly followed by a reflexive pronoun. See the list below.

DIY Means is to do your work yourself rather than employing a professional.

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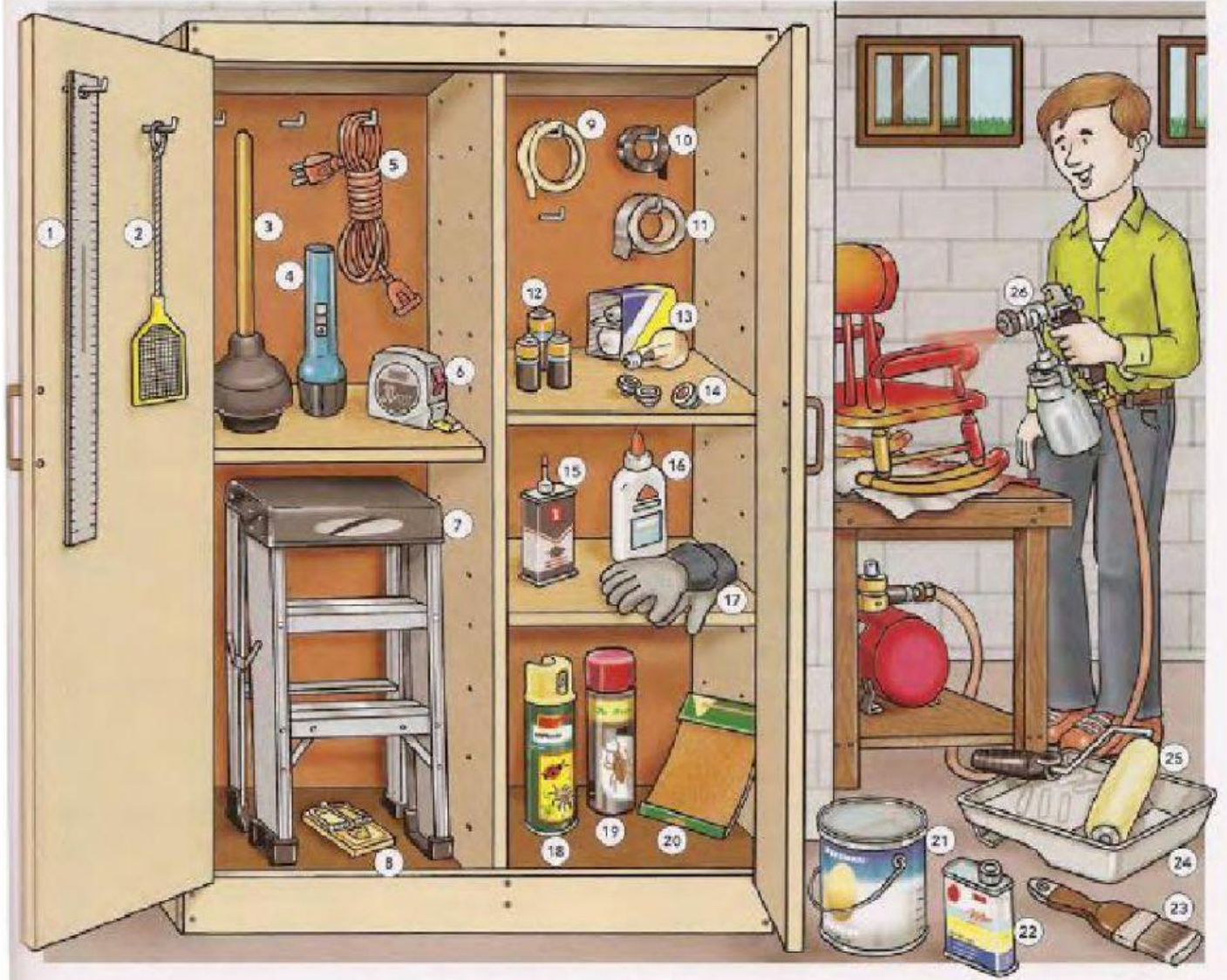
