🕒 Actions that happened in the past but still has a consequence or result in the present	
🕒 Actions referring to the current time	

PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE

(Pretérito Perfecto Simple)

Present perfect affirmative		
Subject	have	Past participle
I / You / We / You / They	've / have	talked.
He / She / It	's / has	talked.
Present perfect negative		
Subject	have	Past participle
I / You / We / You / They	haven't / have not	talked.
He / She / It	hasn't / has not	talked.
