Rules of forming the 3rd person singular (when using he, she it)

The verbs in the 3rd person singular get **-s** ending. There are some spelling rules you have to learn.

1. **Y** changes into **-i** in the end of the verbs if there is a consonant before it.
e.g. try = **tries** but not play = plaies as there is a vowel before the y.
2. If the verb ends with **-ss, -sh, -ch, -o** or **-x** it gets **-es** ending in the 3rd person singular.
e.g. wish=wishes, mix=mixes, watch=watches, miss=misses, go=goes
