The Three Rs

If you want to do more to help the environment, you need to think about the three Rs. They stand for Reduce, Reuse and Recycle. ¹ lots of things you can do. Here are a few.

REDUCE

The first thing you ² to do at home is to reduce the amount of waste that you and your family produce. Reducing begins at the supermarket. You should only buy what you need. You ³ extra things.

REAUSE

You can reuse ⁴ the things that you have at home. If you have a lot of old carrier bags, you can reuse them as ⁵. You can use old jars as containers to keep things like jewellery or pencils in. If you use your imagination, ⁶ of lots of things that you can reuse.

RECYCLE

Buy four bins for the house. Use each one for a different ⁷ : organic waste, paper and cardboard, tins and plastic containers, and glass. ⁸ being organised at home, you will soon ⁹ an expert recycler!
