30	10	5	20	15

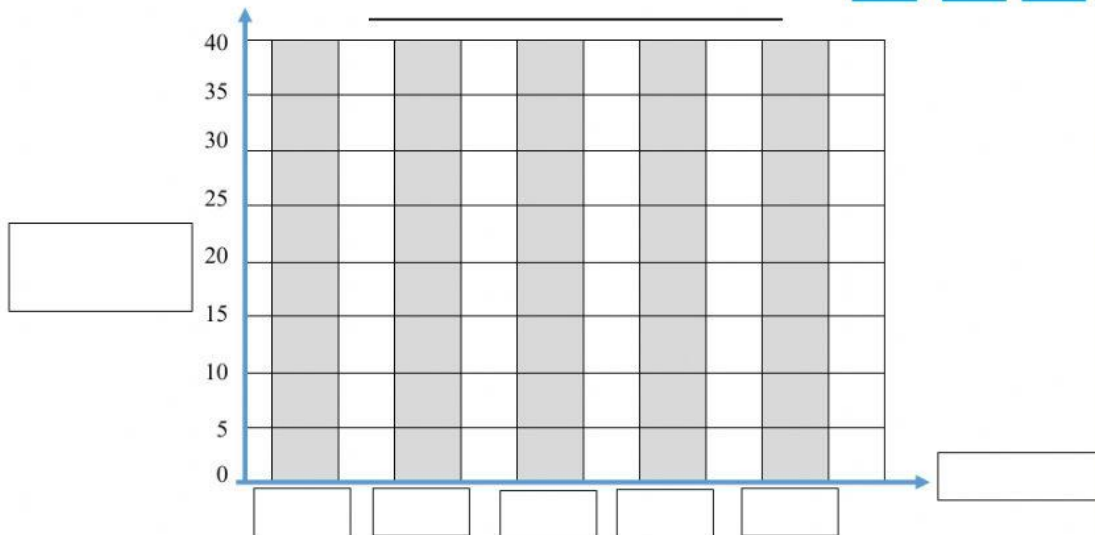
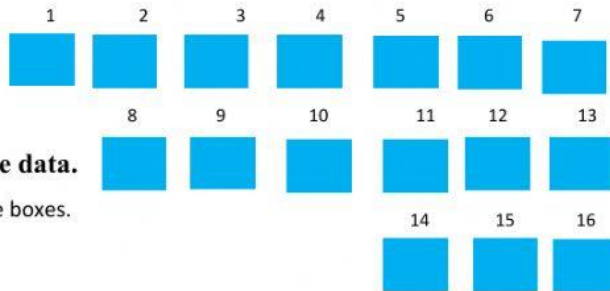
Use the table data to complete the bar graph to show the type and number of animals on Farmer Brown's farm.

5. Farmer Brown wants to have the same number of sheep and goats. How many more sheep does he need to have so the numbers would be equal?
6. The total number of ducks and dogs is equal to the number of sheep. Is that true or false?
6. What is the total number of animals on Farmer Brown's farm?
