It's a big animal.

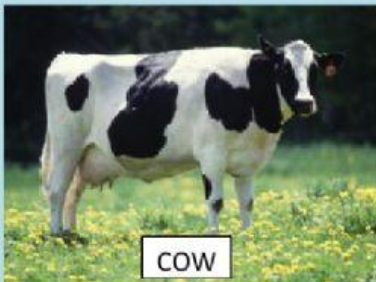
