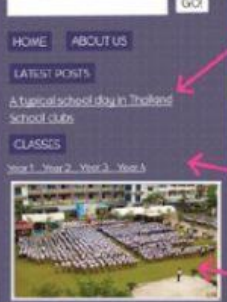
Our English Class Blog

Before we go into our classrooms, we take off our shoes. There are 50 students in my class. We learn maths, science, Thai language, ICT, English, art



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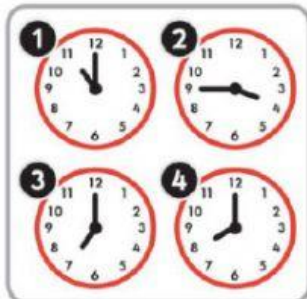
