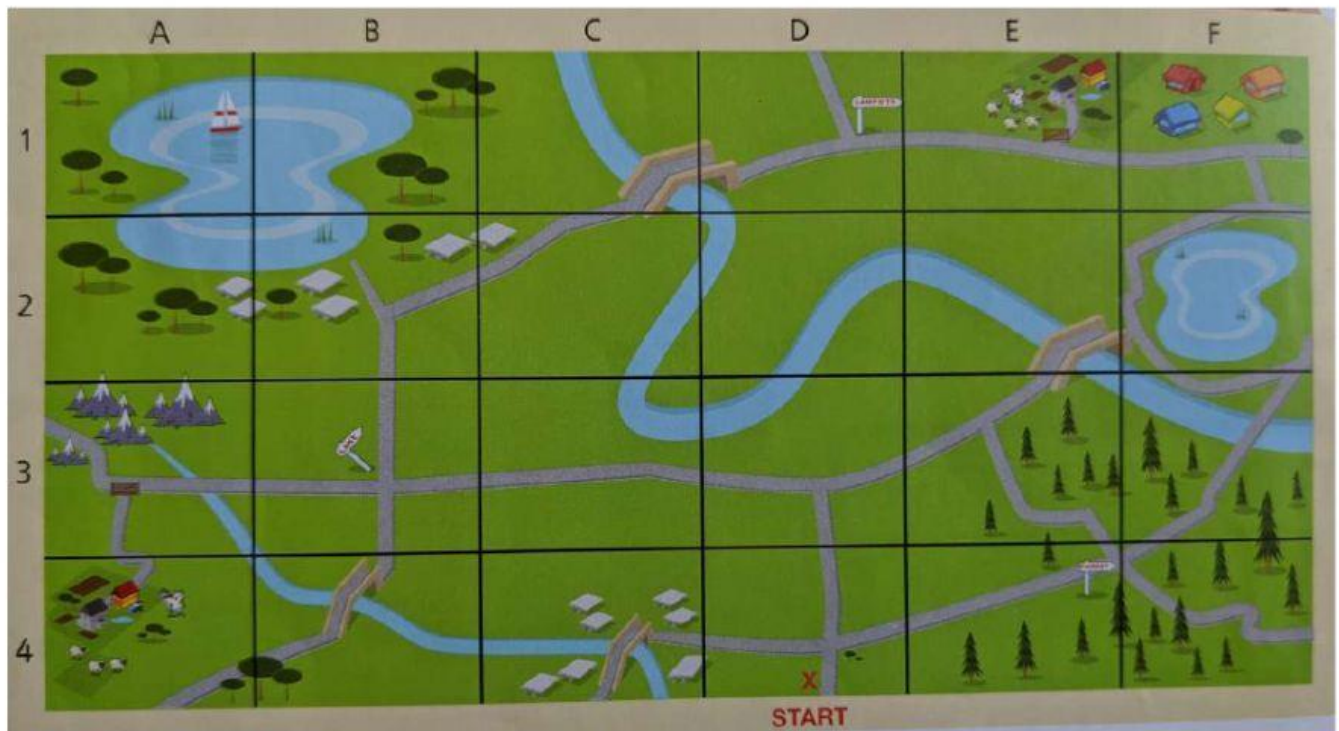


GRAMMAR: GIVING DIRECTIONS (ACTIVITIES)

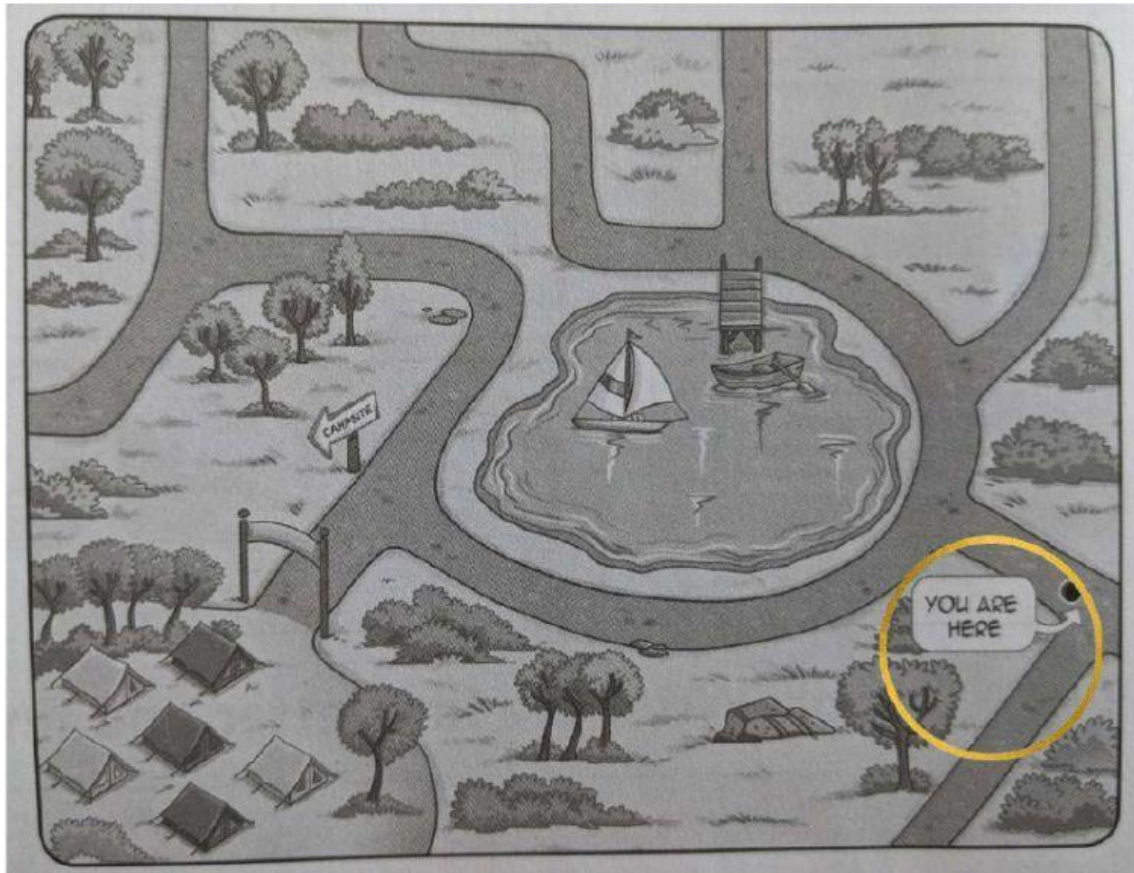
