## ASKING ABOUT ROUTINES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Remember, we use **Wh-questions** to ask for extra information about something or somebody.

Wh-question	Auxiliary Do / Does	Subject	Verb	Complement?
Where	do	you	work	every day?
What	does	your mom	cook	for lunch?

Read the answers. Write questions with **What time**, **Where**, **When**, **What** & **Who** with using the word in bold as a clue.

Example:

**What** **do** **you** study at the Language Center?

**I** study **English** at the Language Center.
