Solidarity of Christianity

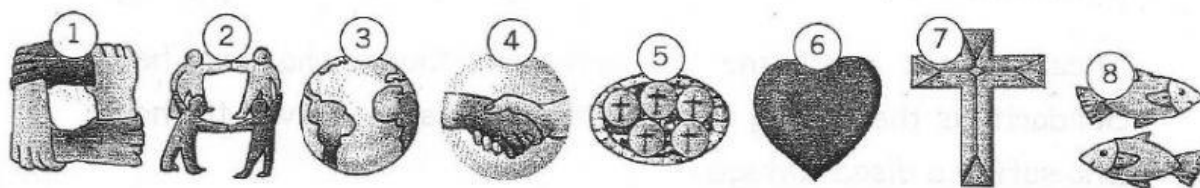
Christianity is the most solidarity religion because it follows the example of Jesus, who defended the poor, healed many sick and gave his life to save people.









Also, Jesus taught that when a person is common with another, it is also in solidarity with Him.
