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Remember: When we want to refer to objects that are **NEAR** we use **THIS/THESE**.

★ When the object is only **ONE(singular)**
we use: **THIS**

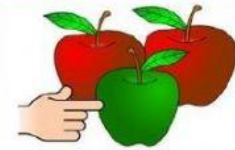
Singular

★ When the object is more than one (**plural**)
we use: **THESE**

Plural
