We use the past perfect continuous...

- ▶ To put emphasis on the duration of an action which started and finished in the past before another past action, usually with for and since.
 - ▶ They had been looking for a house for six months before they found one they liked.
- For an action which lasted for some time in the past and whose result was visible in the past.
 - ▶ Last Friday Roger had to fly to Madrid. His flight was delayed. He was annoyed. He had been waiting at the airport for three hours.
